BIG NEWS!

As most of you know, we came to Honduras as what MTW calls short-term missionaries. This means we are committed for 2-3 years. Through much prayer and many conversations with friends, pastors, teammates, and others, we have decided to pursue going long-term with MTW. This means we will be serving in Honduras for at least another 4 years!

We will finish our 2-year term at the end of November and will go back to the USA for a six-month 'home missionary assignment', at which time we will be catching up with supporters, visiting family, finishing the training required to come back as long-term missionaries, and raising more support. At this point, we are planning to spend about half of the time in PA and half of the time in AZ. We will visit other places but these will be our home bases while we are in the States.



If you read closely, you saw that we will be raising support. Our support level is right where it needs to be as short-term missionaries, but as we be transferring to long-term status, our budget will go up and thus we will be seeking to raise the difference.
